

Rugby Champions – Focus on Glenwood High School

The Rugby Champions programme has been successfully rolled out in Tayside and Fife with thirty four 'Champions' now signed up from across the region. This gives clear indication that people are willing to stand up and push rugby forward along with the development staff.

Of the thirty four schools signed up there are seventeen Bronze, sixteen Silver and one Gold.

Glenwood High School is one of the Bronze emerging schools who until this year had no rugby at all available to its pupils.
